A portion of the dues, however, is not deductible as an ordinary and necessary business expense because the Association engages in lobbying activities. NPA estimates that 55% of dues are allocated to lobbying activities and are nondeductible. Contributions to the Psychology Defense Fund will not be used for lobbying and may be eligible for total business expense deduction.
